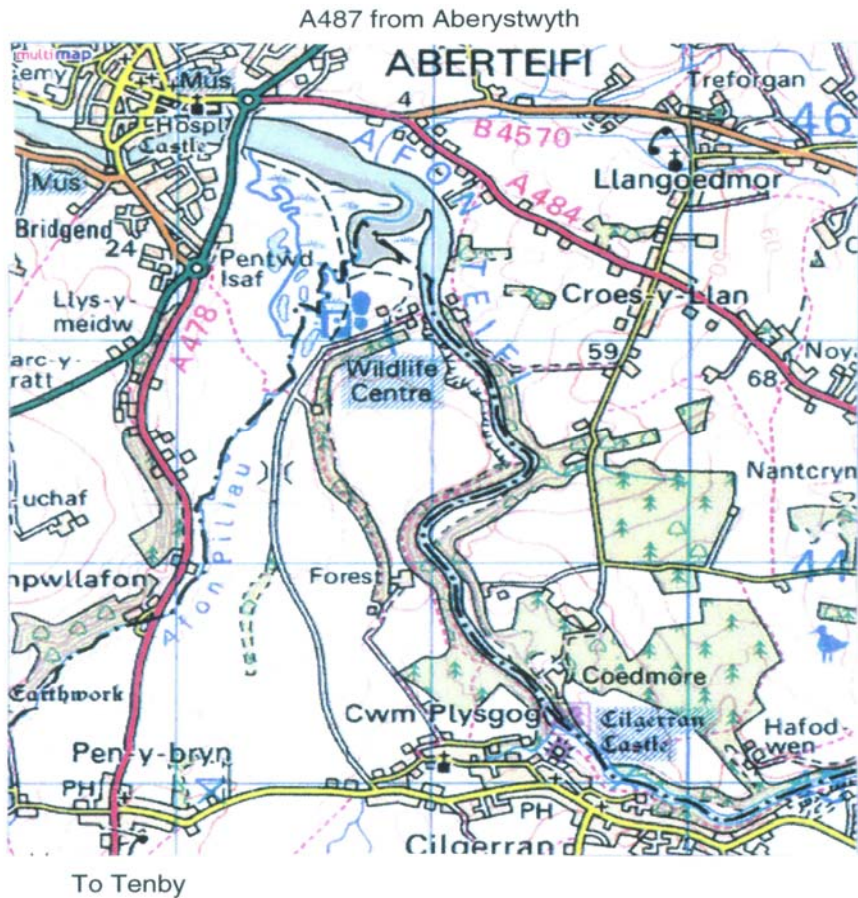


Directions to Welsh Wildlife Centre (Teifi Marshes Nature Reserve),
Cilgerran, Cardigan, SA43 2TB Tel 012139 621600/621212

From the north, approaching via the coast road (A487 Aberystwyth to Cardigan/Aberteifi): as you approach Cardigan, you will go down a hill with the town on your right. At the bottom of the hill go straight over the roundabout and over the River Teifi. Go uphill to the next roundabout and turn left on the A478 to Tenby. Follow this road for about a mile and a half when you reach the village of Pen-y-bryn, and take the first turning left. (There is a brown tourist sign indicating the Welsh Wildlife Centre and also Cilgerran Castle as you approach this village.) About a mile down this road there is a sign pointing to the left for the Welsh Wildlife Centre. Turn up this lane – it is about a mile and a quarter to the centre.

From the south: take M40 then A48 to Carmarthen. Then follow A40 through Whitland to Commercial where there is a roundabout. Turn right up the A478 signposted for Cardigan. Follow this road to the village of Pen-y-bryn where you should turn right in the centre of the village, signposted Cilgerran. Follow as above (for north). Or alternatively, once you reach Carmarthen follow the A484 to Newcastle Emlyn and then to Cardigan. Once you reach the roundabout turn left over the river up to the next roundabout and follow the Tenby road as above (for north).
