

## **Skomer and Skokholm Booking**

Bookings for 2024 have not opened yet, they will open in October and take the following format. Please note bookings are taken by phone only, we will not accept email bookings.

1<sup>st</sup> Monday in October- members of this Wildlife Trust can book Skomer 2nd Monday in October- members of this Wildlife Trust can book Skokholm 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in October- non- members can book either island.

Keep an eye on the website for confirmation of opening dates for booking as they are subject to change.

And please bear the following in mind:

## **Skomer**

- Skomer has 5 rooms. 2 twins, one 3 bed, one 4 bed and one 5 bed mixed sex dormitory. If we do not operate a dormitory in the 5 bed room it can be expensive for smaller groups as you pay a supplement for any bed unused in any room. So in a 5 bed room if there was one person you would pay for 4.5 beds. We would not usually permit this though.
- I always advise to have a choice of dates (maybe up to 3) when making a booking, as your first choice will frequently have gone.
- Changeover days are dictated by the boats (Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays) so stays are for 2,2 and 3 nights only.
- All twin rooms between mid-April and the end of July will book in the first 3 days of open bookings.
- Many do not get on to the island in their first year of trying.

## <u>Skokholm</u>

- Skokholm has 4 single and 8 twin/double rooms.
- Only two boats per week for the majority of the season on a Monday and a Friday dictating stays of 4 or 3 nights respectively.

• Mid May to the end of June one boat per week on a Monday with a stay length of 7 nights.
