## Visiting the Islands

### Skokholm

Skokholm is small and beautiful. It is a quiet and relaxing place with stunning wildlife, including a density of Manx Shearwaters unequalled in the northern hemisphere, and one of the most accessible Storm Petrel colonies in the world.

We are planning a series of one-day trips to Skokholm Island in 2008. These are of course weather dependent, and will be on the following dates (all on Mondays):

May 19  
June 2 and 30  
July 28  
August 11

### Skomer

The boat goes to this rugged and beautiful island several times a day every day of the week (except Mondays - although the boat does operate on Bank Holiday Mondays) from 1 April to 31 October. This gives people up to five hours to enjoy the island. Boats leave Martin's Haven at 10am, 11am and 12 noon and return between 3pm and 4pm as a general rule.

It is also possible to stay on Skomer in newly renovated and refurbished accommodation which can accommodate 15 people. It is self-catering (cooking is by gas - no electricity although there is a small amount for lighting). A 'must' to get to know the island better and to see the nocturnal Shearwaters that are so much a feature of the island.
