

Fern Identification

The course focuses on the ecology and identification of British fern species and will provide participants with relevant identification skills and experience of this under-studied taxonomic group, including:.

- Fern, ecology, taxonomy and life-history
- Species identification and how to distinguish key characteristic features

The course will be delivered through a combination of classroom and outdoor field sessions designed to provide participants with a wide-ranging knowledge of British fern species.

In addition to field surveys on the Parc Slip Nature Reserve, the course will be aided by the use of fern specimens to fully illustrate key identifying features.

- Waterproofs and boots for outdoor activities
- Notepad and pencil
- Camera
- Hand lens
